III. Questions & Answers

QUESTIONS FOR NATIONAL:

Q. What needs to be done to get NCRE up and going? There is a huge amount of support for this across the region but the NCA very rarely answers emails. I have yet to receive back from her and I have DC's that have not received answers either.

Q. I have attempted to contact the NFA regarding regional funds. How am I supposed to manage the funds? What are the regions current funds? Who all do I need to keep in the loop regarding said funds?

QUESTIONS ANSWERED BY REGIONAL:

>From KS-011-D:

Q. Are you still planning to support Courtney's former policy of giving us 5R for on-time reporting? I included it in my report, so I sure hope that is the case.

A. Yes.

Q. Are you planning to support Chris' policy of nominating his ST staff who has on-time reporting for their 5R as well? I sure hope so, since I also included this in my report.

A. Yes

Q. Are you planning on supporting the prestige that I and Chris recommend him for in the RST position? Courtney would pretty much just do exactly what he and I felt he deserved being that I am his DC and see how much work he does on a daily basis.

A. I will award Prestige to the RST based on the very brief (cause I don't want the whole story) summary he sends me along with his recommendations for prestige.

Q. How are you planning on supporting Featured Domain Games? Do you wish it to remain how Chris has it as a domain lets him know when they want one, then they put together the event themselves including all the announcements for it?

A. If it ain't broke don't fix it. I will support Chris in his decisions regarding this.

Q. When members are up for a prestige review that is at a regional or national level, am I to send the log to you after my review, or directly to your prestige reviewers?

A. If you send it to me I will forward it to them. You may send it directly to them as long as I am in the CC line and get in the loop on all communication. Once the Reviewer has finished with the log, I will browse it and then make my decision based on the recommendations of the ARC Prestige.

Q. What are you planning on doing with the Topeka domain? I have already offered to the remaining member(s) that they can join the Lawrence domain if they so wish, but they would need the transfer approval.

A. (12 July 06)I have worked on this issue with national and the remaining member(s) of the domain. As of this report that domain is officially folded. I will be making the appropriate changes in the CRD soon.

Q. What do you suggest that we do about the bad reputation The Camarilla and Cammies have in the Lawrence/KC area which is detrimental to our recruitment?

A. The best, and almost only way, to change this view is to recruit. I understand that it can be hard with a bad rap. An option is to host a game at a game store to show people how the game functions. New blood can override, in time, the opinions of the past.

Q. What is going to be your general award for DCs who submit their reports on time, etc.? Some months I got 30G5R and some months I got 35G5R from Courtney, so was just wondering what I should put down in the reports.

A. I will never have a standard award for this. I will award prestige following a guideline that entails basically on-time report, complete report, summary of report, direct communication.

Q. What is your policy on where to send the report? The list, you and anyone else?

A. All reports are required to be sent to the NC-Reports list and your local list. I would like to also have one directly sent to me. The one sent to me should be the full report. The one sent to the local list is to be edited (removing disciplinary issues, etc.).

Q. What are the dates that are being proposed for NCRE in '07? I'd like to put a bid together for Lawrence, but I emailed Dee, the NCA, one week ago as well as three weeks ago and have not gotten a response from her.

A. I have Found it very hard to get a hold of her as well. I don't have any proposed dates for NCRE in the future but I will hopefully be working on that and be putting this info out to the region.

>From CO-016-D:

Q. I am attempting to re-create the prestige log of one of my members. I have found a good amount of his prestige in both prior CC and DC reports, however, I am unable to find records for him prior to January of 2003. Is there a place where chapter reports from prior to January, 2003 are archived?

When a Coordinator reaches 3 months of consecutive on-time and complete reporting, 5 Prestige of their award will be converted to Regional Prestige. In other words, if your award would be 40 General Prestige, you will instead receive 35 General and 5 Regional Prestige. For each additional month that you are on-time and complete, you will also have 5 Prestige of your award converted. If you are late or incomplete on a report, your count will start over. In other words, if you are on-time and complete 2 months in a row, late on the third month and on-time and complete on the fourth month, you will be considered to be on time 1 month and need 2 more months of on-time complete reporting to receive the award.
