be listed in your domain reports. From now on DC's who fail to put these awards into their reports will be docked prestige from their monthly award from me. As the RC I award prestige to the RST, ARST's, ARC's, and DC's, along with CC's and VST's from Independent Chapters.

When a Coordinator reaches 3 months of consecutive on-time and complete reporting, 5 Prestige of their award will be converted to Regional Prestige. In other words, if your award would be 40 General Prestige, you will instead receive 35 General and 5 Regional Prestige. For each additional month that you are on-time and complete, you will also have 5 Prestige of your award converted. If you are late or incomplete on a report, your count will start over. In other words, if you are on-time and complete 2 months in a row, late on the third month and on-time and complete on the fourth month, you will be considered to be on time 1 month and need 2 more months of on-time complete reporting to receive the award. Under each Coordinator's name is a listing of the months, starting in July. Underneath each month is a letter: N means No Report, I means Incomplete Report, L means Late Report, O means Late and Incomplete Report, R means On time and Complete Report. This format may change, so check here for any clarifications.

Q. We are still working on getting our DST election underway now that Julian stepped down. I emailed the new NST and he has yet to respond. I am emailing again today.

A. My recommendation at this point is to wait for the new RST to take office. My understanding is that voting ended on December 9, so it should be announced soon.

From KS-016-C

Q. Burn out. I feel it coming. Thankfully I gave up my ADST Archivist position this month, so have less stress. But I'm still getting very burned out by dealing with people that constantly gripe and complain. They either need to get off their behind and do something about it, or shut up. With one particular person, it's getting old...very, very old. Not to mention causing waves throughout this Domain, and the one next door. The person isn't in my chapter so I can't do anything directly. And yes, folks who need to know, know. But if the person isn't actually outright violating the CoC, then there's naught that can be done. I think there's too much apathy...too much "I don't want to have to deal with it" for anything constructive to get done.

It's pretty bad when folks (myself included) don't want to go to a game or a meeting because they're sick of this person's continual gripe and whine. And still...folks don't want to deal with them, so nothing is done about it. I would go so far as to say that this one person is the reason that many folks don't come to some meetings (actually I know of at least five persons that have flat out stated such) and why several quit coming to some games. But again, they aren't violating the CoC...it's just their attitude and personality driving folks away. So what can be done?

A. Document every little thing that even edges on violating the CoC. Most people forget that one of the tenants of the CoC is "Be Courteous of Others". If someone is constantly discourteous, there are measure that can be taken. If nothing is being done locally or if the local officials feel that they have a conflict of interest in the case, my door is always open.

Q. Domain Boundaries...this is a question that has come up. Now that we've been given Kansas chapter numbers, some folks are confused as to whether or not we are now a Kansas Domain, still a Kansas/Missouri Domain. The problem is that at least one person has used/is using this as an excuse to transfer to become an Independent member of the Great Lakes Region. He still lives within the area delineated by the Domain boundaries, but since the chapters now have KS designations, he claims to live within the boundaries of GL since he resides in Missouri. I think this needs to be clarified by National

or the Cam Council. Exactly where do our boundaries as a Domain now fall, and if only in Kansas, what about the 50+ members of the Domain that live in Missouri? Will we all need to get National permission to be in NC Region? My recommendation: The Dark Heartland Domain cover the six counties that it has primarily covered for all these years. Three on the Kansas side (Wyandotte, Johnson, and Leavenworth), and three on the Missouri side (Jackson, Clay and Platte). Then anyone within the 30 mile radius of the point where I-70 crosses the KS/MO border can join the Domain without RC/NC approval (that's where the original boundaries of the NC "bubble" into Missouri were defined).

A. The boundaries have not changed and will not change. The designations are all that changed. I believe Misty has taken to calling the KC Domain, the Domain for the Greater Kansas City Area (or something to that effect), which I think is a great way to put it. KC is still part of the NC Region and anyone with the Domain boundaries as currently set out can join without any special cross-regional approval. If someone is trying to use this as an excuse to leave the region, then it is up to the CC and the DC to either not approve the transfer or make me aware of the possible deception going on. As I am not there, I have to go by the information given to me by the officers. If more clarification needs to be given, please let me know.

From KS-017-C

Q. How, if the coordinator above someone didn't report, can you get prestige for a job you ARE doing?

A. Contact their supervising officer (i.e., Me or Wes for someone in the *C Chain and the new RST or David Bounds for someone in the *ST Chain).

Q. This is just a chapter discussion we had, we think there should be set rules to time limits and such for all elections. The handbook (page 85) says the time limit suggested it two weeks. But too many people work off of suggested and do whatever they want, We think the two weeks should be required.

A. It depends on the election and which part of the time frame you are referring to. Personally, on any election I run or that is run in the *C Chain, I want to see no less than 2 weeks for applications to be turned in and no less than 2 weeks for actual voting. The part where I see the most flexibility is in the period of time allotted to review applications and ask questions. If

it is a fairly small group of people voting and there's only 1 person running, chances are you can combine the voting time and the review time. If there is a specific incident you wish to discuss, please contact me.

From KS-020-D
